

Cruise Lines Wordsearch

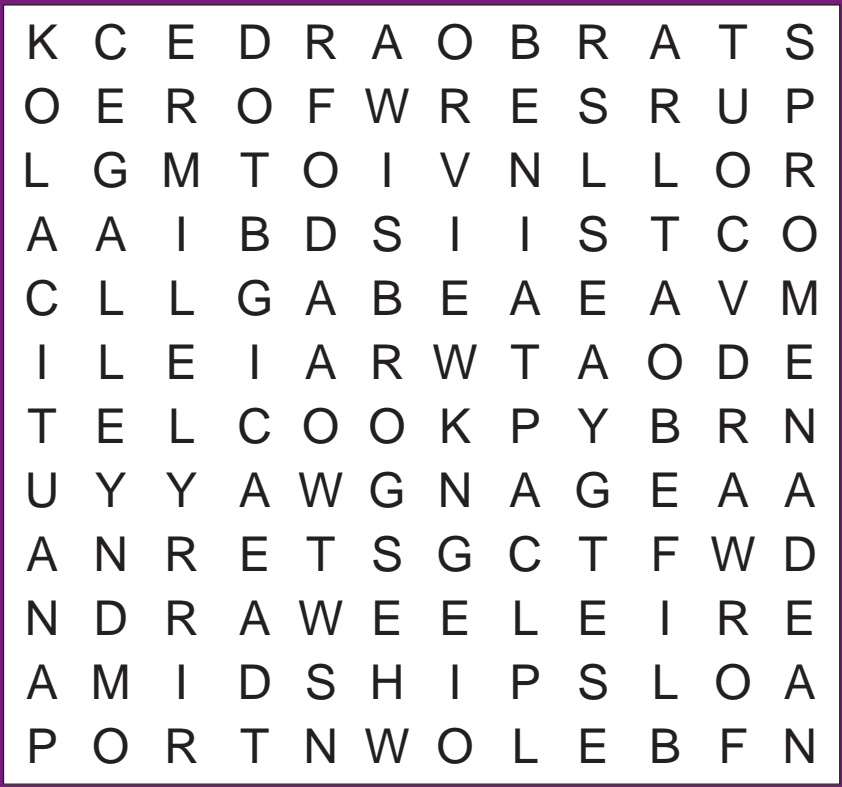
